Did you hear about the little boy who threw the clock out the window? He wanted to see time fly. It hardly seems possible, but in June, Nueva Esperanza will celebrate its twenty-fifth anniversary! In June of 1994, we began the early-morning services that became Iglesia Bautista Nueva Esperanza. During those twenty-five years, we've met in three locations and belonged to two associations, but we've preached only one Gospel.

The Lord had given us the privilege of seeing many people respond during that time. Nearly one hundred have been baptized through the farm workers in our area and evangelized far-away friends and family members over the telephone and via Internet. As we praise God for his faithfulness, would you join me in praying for even greater fruit in our next twenty-five years? Thank you for the role you play in making this ministry possible!

One update to my last newsletter article, in which I asked you to pray for our outreach to farm workers: during the month of May, we saw two decisions for Christ as a result of our ministry on farms.
